

Use it how you wish but I use these rules:

- Say the career aloud – if you both agree – the square is yours. Place an X or O over the square and/or write career.
  - If you disagree – ask.
- You want a square but do not know the answer or answered incorrectly – must choose a different square.
  - Yes – Even if the other person will win the game – choose a different square. “It’s just a game – You will be fine.”
- Cat wins the game. Turn the page over and play a normal game of tic tac toe.
  - The cat gets the game again – rock, paper, scissors.
